# THE HAMPTON SITE

IN THE SIXTEENTH CENTURY THIS SITE ADJOINED THE ROYAL MEWS AND WAS AN AREA OF STABLES AND COACH HOUSES. WHITING STREET WAS KNOWN AS HEDGE LANE. THE DUKE OF MONTMOUTH OWNED PROPERTY HERE AND GAVE HIS NAME TO MONTMOUTH COURT WHICH WAS SHOWN ON PLANS OF THE AREA AS LATE AS 1874. THROUGHOUT THE 19TH CENTURY THE STREET REMAINED RESIDENTIAL.

SHOPFRONTS THEN APPEARED WITH THE FRONT ROOMS OF BUILDINGS SET TO ONE AND DEFEAT TO THE WALL. THE BUILDINGS WERE MADE OF BRICK AND WERE BUILT BY THE DUKE OF MONTMOUTH.
